## Policies

### *Registration*

Classes have a limited enrollment and will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Persons may register for classes at The Wynne Home Arts Center. Students must pay the class fee at registration.

### *Scholarships*

A limited number of scholarships are available . Scholarships are based on need and early application.

### *Late Registration*

Persons may register for a class by bringing a registration form and the fee to the first class meeting only if the stated limit of the class was not reached prior to the beginning of the class. No one may register after the second class meeting.

### *Discontinued Classes*

An activity may be cancelled if there is insufficient registration. Cancellations will be decided before the second class meeting.

### *Refunds*

Full refunds will be made if a course is cancelled by the Wynne Home Arts Center. Persons who officially withdraw from an activity at any time prior to second class meeting may receive an 80% refund of the fees.
