

No Smoking Ordinance FAQs

Why did the City of Huntsville decide to prohibit smoking in public places and in places of employment?

The purpose of the ordinance is to promote public health by decreasing citizens' exposure to secondhand smoke, thereby creating smoke-free environments for workers and citizens through regulations in the work place and all public places.

What is the effective date of the smoking ordinance?

Active enforcement will begin on July 5, 2017.

Are e-cigarettes and vaping allowed under this ordinance?

No. The ordinance is all inclusive and prohibits all such devices in all places where smoking is not allowed.

Who do I contact to file a complaint about a violation of the smoking ordinance?

Any citizen who desires to register a complaint under this chapter may initiate enforcement with the City of Huntsville non-emergency number at 936-294-5700 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 936-435-8001 after hours.

Where is smoking prohibited?

Smoking is prohibited in all enclosed areas within a place of employment without exception. This includes restaurants, bars, retail establishments, offices, and other public places. Smoking is also prohibited within 20' of any public entrance to a facility within the city.

What types of establishments are exempt from the smoking ordinance?

Smoking is not regulated in private residences (except when used as childcare or health care facilities), designated guest rooms in hotels, retail tobacco stores, designated private or semi-private rooms in nursing homes, and fraternal organizations.

▶ Who is responsible for enforcement of the smoking ordinance?

It is the responsibility of the owner, manager, operator, or employee of any establishment to enforce the regulations of the ordinance at their establishment.

> Can an individual be issued a citation if they smoke within 20 feet of a public entrance?

Yes. Any person observed smoking where smoking is prohibited by ordinance is individually responsible for the violation.

What is the penalty for violating the smoking ordinance?

Violations of the ordinance are a Class C Misdemeanor and may result in a citation filed with Municipal Court, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.

> As an employer do I have to post the appropriate signage?

Yes. The employer or owner/operator in charge is responsible for posting "No Smoking" signage.
