### Application for Ballot by Mail

Applications must be submitted by mail, common or contract carrier, fax or email.

*Note: If a voter submits the application via fax or email, the Early Voting Clerk must receive the original application via mail and within four days of receipt of the electronic copy.*

### Qualifications to apply:

If a voter is 65 years of age or older on Election Day, has a disability, is confined in jail, or will be outside the county during early voting hours and on Election Day, the voter can apply to vote by mail.

### Deadline to apply for Ballot by Mail:

The application must be RECEIVED no later than Friday, October 25<sup>th</sup> by 5:00 pm.
