THE CITY OF HUNTSVILLE

The City of Huntsville, Texas began its development in 1835. Pleasant Gray, a native of the United States of the North, was attracted by the generous provisions of the colonization laws of the State of Coahuila & Texas. He petitioned the state to admit him in the class of colonists and to concede to him one league of land (4,428.40 acres) in the vacant tracts of the enterprise. The City's founding father, Pleasant Gray, along with his wife, Hannah and three children, was awarded one league of land on July 12, 1835. This land, called Nacogdoches, was situated on colonist Wiley Parker's survey.

A trading post was soon established by Pleasant Gray. He sold lots to settlers moving into the area. Soon the settlement grew into a town and Pleasant Gray named it "Huntsville," after Huntsville, Alabama, his former residence. When Montgomery County was created in 1837, by an Act of the Legislature, Gray's settlement lay within its boundaries.

On January 30, 1845, Huntsville was incorporated as a town in the County of Montgomery, by act of the Senate and House of Representatives of the Republic of Texas in Congress. Huntsville's city limits then extended one-half mile in every direction from the center of the public square. The Chief Justice of Montgomery County ordered an election to elect one mayor and six aldermen, a collector or constable, treasurer and secretary for one year terms.

On December 29, 1845, Texas became a state and was annexed into the Union and subject to the Constitution. When Walker County was formed from a part of Montgomery County in 1846, Huntsville was designated as the county seat.

On January 19, 1852, Huntsville was incorporated as a town in the County of Walker in the State of Texas, as enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas. Huntsville's city limits were extended one mile square, the center of

which was the public square. The Chief Justice of Walker County ordered an election to be held at the Courthouse in Huntsville to elect five aldermen, who then were to organize and elect one of their number as mayor, and then elect a treasurer, a bailiff and other such officers they required.

After the Civil War broke out in 1861, Texas declared its separation from the Union and joined the Confederacy. After the war and reconstruction, the State adopted a new constitution. Huntsville was incorporated under the new constitution on May 4, 1871. A mayor and five aldermen served two year terms. Later, in 1874, the Legislature passed an act which reflected an early willingness to leave the responsibility for local government at the local level. This act permitted local citizens to amend any charter granted by the Legislature. It is believed the City Council of the City of Huntsville passed an ordinance some time during the period 1875-1886 to amend their 1871 charter to allow for the City to be divided into three wards and for each ward to have two representatives on the City Council. The City Council minutes of 1886 indicate the city was operating with six aldermen, two elected from each of the three wards.

In 1950, the city evolved to the four ward system and two aldermen were elected from each ward and the mayor continued to serve at-large. In 1968, a new home rule charter was adopted. The mayor and four aldermen were elected at-large and one alderman was elected from each of the four wards, respectively.

In 1973, the City of Huntsville established the City Manager/Mayor and Council form of government; a plan which was earlier defeated in 1937 when it was proposed in a charter amendment election. A city manager was appointed by the Mayor and City Council to be the chief administrative and executive officer of the City to be responsible to the Council for the proper administration of all of the affairs of the City.

The City's charter of 1968, with its four subsequent amendments (1970, 1972, 1979 and 1982) continues to serve the City today. The charter is reviewed by a

citizens committee each five years. The committee reports to the City Council regarding its recommendations for amendments. The Council then considers submitting the amendments to the people in a charter amendment election.

A tabulation of Huntsville's elected representatives follows. Because of the loss of three early city council meeting minute books of the City of Huntsville (Volume A, 1845-1886; Volumes C and D, 1893-1913), some of this information is unavailable.
