









Your Blue Recycling Cart Specifics



Your blue recycling cart is provided to you free of cost. The recycling program is voluntary, and we encourage you to take part. If you choose to participate in the program, there are some very specific guidelines that need to be followed. These carts are to be used for specific types of items:







Plastic Bottles

Examples include:

-  Water bottles
-  Milk bottles
-  Shampoo bottles
-  Hand soap bottles
-  Soda bottle
-  Juice bottles






Paper Products

Examples include

-  Office paper
-  Junk mail
-  Small cardboard boxes
-  Toilet paper tubes
-  News paper
-  Magazines

Cans

Examples include

-  Soda cans
-  Beer cans
-  Soup/vegetable cans
-  Coffee cans
-  Pet food cans

All of these items must be clean, and placed in your blue cart loose. No film plastic. **No grocery/plastic garbage bags allowed.** If the item does not fall into one of these three categories, it belongs in your regular green garbage cart, or you may find another organization to make donations to.
